### ***WHY THE TRUTH PROJECT?***

The latest survey shows that 70% of Americans consider themselves to be Christian. HOWEVER, just 6% actually possess a Biblical worldview (based on a set of **very** fundamental questions such as: is there absolute truth?, is the Bible the infallible Word of God?, etc.) We would think that the percentage is very different for the true, believing church. But we'd be wrong. Among those who self-identify as born-again, evangelical Christians, the number is 9%.

We are confident that the percentage is much higher at Candlelight. But even if it were 5 times higher - that would still be less than 50%!

If that stuns and concerns you, the Truth Project is something you should prayerfully consider. It's goal is to equip believers with God's truth in a systematic and comprehensive way - showing that there is no place you can turn in this world that God has not given us His truth: science, history, philosophy, government and every other aspect of our world and lives.
